

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy is a part of our Terms of Service. As a result, we use the same terminology, and if you have any doubts regarding the definition or meaning of any word or term herein, you should consult our Terms of Service, which is legal contract you are agreeing to by using this Site.

This Site is constructed such that you can visit us on the web without specifically identifying yourself or revealing any personal information. 5. Additional Website Issues

(a) How Affinity Uses Technology to Improve Your Affinity Experience

Affinity uses cookies and web beacons, described below, to collect information about the pages you view, the links you click and other actions you take on our website. Additionally, we collect certain standard information your browser sends to every website you visit, such as your IP address, browser type and language, access times and referring website addresses.

Most aggregate information is collected via cookies, web beacons and other technical methods. Web beacons, also known as clear gifs, in conjunction with cookies, are used to compile statistics about website usage. Web beacons are small pieces of data embedded in images on the pages of websites or applications. We or our service providers use these technical methods to analyze the traffic patterns on our website, such as the frequency with which our users visit various parts of the website and to measure site effectiveness or use of online products and services.
